

SHOW YOUR CAR AND SUPPORT MISSIONS THIS SATURDAY


The car show is this Saturday! It will be great fun on a great day so come out and play and, by the way, enter your car from Botany Bay. That's pretty bad but here's the point.




DEACON SELECTION THIS SUNDAY, DECEMBER 06

CAROLS AT THE RIDGE


